Welcome to the 2006 Pawnee City Junior High Invitational Track Meet at Pawnee City. We are pleased to have the opportunity to host this meet this year and are excited that you will be here to participate. This year's meet date is **Thursday, April 13, 2006 beginning at 10:00 A.M.** We hope your stay will be rewarding.

Enclosed please find the schedule of events, workers and timers schedules pertaining to the meet. Please have your entry form submitted to us by **12:00 P.M. Thursday, April 6.** The link for the entries is [www.lewistonsports.com/track](http://www.lewistonsports.com/track) select the Track Meet Entry Form in the upper right side, instruction are posted on the login page. After completing the entries, click on the Print your entries button and fax those pages to the number listed on that page by **12:00 A.M. Friday, April 7.** Your password is Boys \_\_\_\_\_ Girls \_\_\_\_\_.

Entries are unlimited in each event and one entry per school per relay. We do this to allow all athletes to participate, however, we will only score the first three from each school. Please note that you may not add athletes the day of the meet, however, you will be allowed to replace an entered athlete with another from your team. A scratch meeting will be held at 8:30 A.M. next to the concession stand.

If teams want to set up camp, there will be plenty of areas available outside the track. No tents will be allowed inside the track or on the west end.

### **ITEMS OF INFORMATION:**

1. Field events will start at 9:00 a.m. and running events at approximately 10:30 a.m.
2. Scoring is 10-8-6-4-2-1
3. Your awards and results may be picked up after the meet. Six medals will be given for all events and three places in relays. Team Champion and Runner-up Plaques will be awarded.
4. Please dress at home. No locker facilities will be available.
5. We ask that all coaches, spectators and athletes stay in the grandstand area. Only participants will be allowed on the track and finish line area.
6. School buses park one block south of the track in the city parking lot. Fans may use the parking lots and a new lot across the street south of the track.
7. The High School buildings are off limits to all athletes.
8. Spike length is 1/8" maximum. Any longer length will result in immediate disqualification in all events for the athlete or removal of their shoes.
9. Please use only chalk on runways for marks—NO TAPE
10. Please do not allow students to set up camp inside the track or on the west end.
11. Admission is \$3.00 for Adults and \$2.00 for students.
12. Concessions and restrooms will be in the building on the East end of the track.
13. Please clean up your area before you leave for the day.
