All competitors get three trials. The top eight will advance to the finals and those will get three additional trials. In the High Jump and Pole Vault, each competitor will get three attempts at each height.

RUNNING EVENTS

The eight fastest times will advance from the preliminaries to the finals.

First, Second and Third Place Plaques

Medals will be given for the first six places, except in relays where only 1st, 2nd and 3rd medals will be given. (In the event of a tie, a coin flip by the coaches involved will determine the medal winner.)

This year's meet date is **Tuesday, April 25, 2006 beginning at 3:00 P.M.** We hope your stay will be rewarding.

Enclosed please find the schedule of events, workers and timers schedules pertaining to the meet. Please have your entry form submitted to us by **12:00 P.M. Thursday, April 20.** The link for the entries is www.lewistonSports.com/track select the Track Meet Entry Form in the upper right side. Follow the entry instructions that are posted on the site. After completing the entries, click on the print your entries button and fax those pages to the number listed on that page after entries are complete.

Entries are three in each event and one entry per school per relay. Please note that you may not add athletes the day of the meet, however, you will be allowed to replace an entered athlete with another from your team. A scratch meeting will be held at 2:30 P.M. next to the concession stand.

If teams want to set up camp, there will be plenty of areas available outside the track. No tents will be allowed inside the track or on the west end.

ITEMS OF INFORMATION:

1. Field events will start at 3:00 p.m. and running events at approximately 4:30 p.m.
2. Scoring is 10-8-6-4-2-1
3. Your awards and results may be picked up after the meet. Six medals will be given for all events and three places in relays. Team Champion and Runner-up Plaques will be awarded.
4. Please dress at home. No locker facilities will be available.
5. We ask that all coaches, spectators and athletes stay in the grandstand area. Only participants will be allowed on the track and finish line area.
6. School buses park one block south of the track in the city parking lot. Fans may use the parking lots and a new lot across the street south of the track.
7. The High School buildings are off limits to all athletes.
8. Spike length is 1/8" maximum. Any longer length will result in immediate disqualification in all events for the athlete or removal of their shoes.
9. Please use only chalk on runways for marks—NO TAPE
10. Please do not allow students to set up camp inside the track or on the west end.
11. Admission is \$3.00 for Adults and \$2.00 for students.
12. Concessions and restrooms will be in the building on the East end of the track.
13. Please clean up your area before you leave for the day.
